A bill to make September 11th a national day of mourning was introduced on October 25, 2001, by Rep. Vito Fossella (R-NY). After unanimous votes in both the House and the Senate, President Bush signed the resolution into law on December 18. And then on September 4, 2002, President Bush used the authority of the resolution to proclaim September 11, 2002, as the first Patriot Day.

On the morning of September 11th, we were all stunned by the billowing black smoke against a brilliant blue sky, and we mourned the loss of thousands of precious lives. The images and events of that fateful day have left an indelible imprint in our hearts and minds.
