Thick straw was covering the barn floor. The minutes turned into hours. We worked and worked to help this mama bring her new calf into the world but it was hard work. Even in the coldest night I could ever remember, my husband was stripped down to just his pants and boots. Time was not on our side and certainly not on the calf's side. We watched, feeling defeated, and very sad as the mother cow cleaned her baby. All of a sudden, I saw a piece of straw stick in the calf's eye and it flinched. Miraculously, the baby then lifted its head. Tears rolled down my cheeks. Tears of relief, of gratitude, and happiness fell like rain. We felt sure we had witnessed a true miracle.

Child of God, our story may be much the same. We are seemingly dead in our sin, far from God, determined to fight Him tooth and nail. It seems there is no hope for our soul. Then, all of a sudden, something in our life pricks our soul and we are alive, searching for joy and turn to our only solace, a savior, our only hope. Maybe this is a physical pain or an emotional pain but the hurt can only be healed by Him.

I think of the woman at the well; a woman who is as low as she can get but Jesus saw her heart and he healed her brokenness. He filled her with joy she could not keep to herself. 
