Benevolence on Barwick

If you “follow” any of the news outlets — local, state, or national, you will get a plethora of stories and opinions. Now, many believe their favorite news source is the only one that is giving truth. The more I listen to *News*, the more confused I can get. When confused, people get all caught up in what they believe to be true (and it may be true) without running it through the filter of discernment. This very thing has had my soul stirred up as of late.

As I listened to my favorite podcast this morning, the scripture reference today was Acts 16.

In Acts 16, beginning with verse 16, the story tells of a servant girl who is enslaved to a powerful group as a fortune teller for the profit of her captors. She is following the disciples around saying, “These men are the servants of the Most High God, who proclaim to us the way of salvation.”

She did this for many days until Paul, having discernment, realized she was demon-possessed and cast the demon from this girl. You see, Paul did not appreciate nor need the demon-possessed girl’s endorsement. While studying all this today, this jumped out at me; the company you keep, even if they are saying all the right things and appear to be “on your side,” they may be speaking truth through the wrong spirit.

Paul recognized this child was demon-possessed and cast the demon out. This made her owners very angry because she was generating revenue for them from her divinations. Their money source was now gone. Paul and Silas were arrested, beaten and imprisoned for delivering this girl from the demon.

The thing that struck me was that she wasn’t saying untrue things. She wasn’t speaking against them and seemingly was endorsing them BUT truth coming from a wrong spirit is not an advantage. She may have been saying all the right things for the wrong reasons.

Pray for discernment in these confusing times. Delay your reactions and examine the source. Realize a good story, even with a smiling face, may be coming from the wrong spirit.
